Jeffrey McFarland-Johnson has inspired others in his artistic pursuits in breaking new musical ground and the boundaries of his primary instrument, the cello. Mr. Johnson's concert takes on the staple of the violoncello, the Bach solo cello suites, and transforms them with the Heitzman CelloGuitar, an instrument constructed for him specifically to perform the Bach cello suites. Terry Mills, lute and Spanish guitar, expands the evening with Renaissance and 20<sup>th</sup> Century selection duos with acoustic cello. The evening concludes with a jazz improvisation interpretation, entitled **Bachjazz**, of a Bach solo cello suite with amplified cello, Jay Goetting on contrabass, and Alan U'Ren on drum set.
